## **CAMPSITE APPLICATION**

This document outlines the general guidelines for camping on your recreational license. Please review all information prior to submitting your application.



The purpose of this document is to establish clear and consistent policies for camping on your recreational license. Roseburg Resources Co. reserves the right to amend these policies at any time.

- Camping is not permitted on every property. When it is permitted, camping is limited to designated sites.
- All campsite structures must be capable of being moved on demand (i.e., mounted on skids or wheels).
- No permanent residence will be permitted at campsites.
- ♦ Campsite grounds must be kept clean and free of litter at all times. Garbage must not be burned or buried. All garbage must be removed from the Property and disposed of properly. Junk or unserviceable equipment of any kind, including scrap lumber or metal, must be removed from property. Any structures not in use must be removed.
- No chemicals of any kind will be stored at the campsite. No petroleum products, except propane, may be stored at the campsite in containers larger than 5 gallons. Petroleum containers must be OSHA approved (spill proof).
